- 6. Clean up after the Café closes (4pm to 5:30pm)

One hour Adult Volunteer commitments from each family are required for your child to participate. Below is a sign-up form for you to complete with your child. Depending upon the number of Fifth Grade volunteers, the children will have either a 30 minute shift or a 60 minute shift.
