Invensys Foxboro YMCA Policies

Parental Supervision Policy

Members under 10 years old must be supervised by an adult when visiting the facility. In our facilities, parental supervision means that your child is within an arm's length of an adult. Please note: YMCA Staff is not responsible for the supervision of your child at this event.

Swim Test Policy

Attention: Everyone under the age of 18 must be swim tested to go into the pool.

After taking the swim test you will receive either a red or a green bracelet. *Those under the age of 10 must have an adult on the pool deck at all times.*

Red Bracelet – Must remain in the shallow portion of the pool. Children under the age of 9 must have an adult over the age of 18 in the pool with them. Those 9 or over must remain in the shallow portion of the pool.

Green Bracelet – You are allowed to swim in the pool without an adult. You can also swim in the deep portion of the pool.
