Invensys Foxboro YMCA Policies

Parental Supervision Policy

Members under 10 years old must be supervised by an adult when visiting the facility. In our facilities, parental supervision means that your child is within an arm's length of an adult. Please note: YMCA Staff is not responsible for the supervision of your child at this event.

Swim Test Policy

All swimmers under 14 years old will be swim tested in the deep end in order to enter the pool. Please plan accordingly!

Those under the age of 10 must have an adult on the pool deck at all times.

If a swimmer does not pass the swim test, he/she is required to stay in the shallow end and have a parent in the water and within arms reach (2-non swimmers for every parent in the water).

If a swimmer passes, he/she will receive a bracelet or a mark which will allow them to swim in the pool without an adult. You can also swim in the deep portion of the pool.
